

Parents, if you haven't had an opportunity to talk about gun safety with your children recently, please take a few minutes to do so. Please make sure to emphasize if your child were to find a firearm what they should do: 1.

Assume it is real and **DO NOT TOUCH**. 2. Leave the area. 3. Tell a trusted adult. I know this seems like basic common sense, but this is an important one to cover with your children.

At Safety School, Sgt. Eichler and I have used the Eddie Eagle video and handouts for the past several years. This program recently went through an update, so the video is new and a lot more up to date than the previous version. There's other gun safety videos/programs for kids that a quick google search will bring up.

Counselor's Corner




