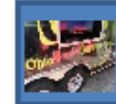

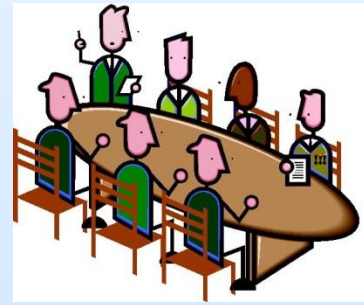


Hello Munroe PTA! My name is Ofc. Dave Quillen and I am the Tallmadge Police Department's School Resource Officer.

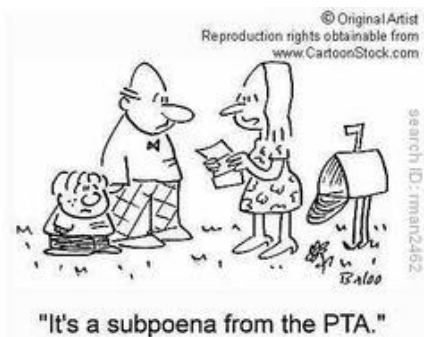
